Kosec recently hosted an event at her West Palm Beach home, where she presented her gift to Abbey Strauss, MD, a member of Boca Raton's Promise and President of the Florida Psychiatric Association. Attending were members of Boca Raton's Promise, the Action Alliance and other mental health advocates.

Kosec, a long-time donor to Boca Raton's Promise, provided the gift in honor of the late Lord and Lady Anthony Jacobs, long time benefactors of the Breaking The Silence initiative. The Jacobs' provided \$410,000 from 2008 to 2014 to fund mental health education and awareness projects in Palm Beach County. This support made it possible for the Action Alliance to introduce "Breaking the Silence" curriculum at five elementary schools, produce the Lovewell musical "Weight of Words" at five high schools, expand after-school FRiENDS clubs in middle schools, and help provide Mental Health First Aid training to 1,000 adults in Palm Beach County.
